ROYAL SLAM forced the issue, led into the turn, set the pace, was passed midstretch and gave way. BOLD BIRDIE raced in midpack, was hustled into the stretch then flattened out. ALPHA AWAY set a pressured pace, was headed, pressed the leader on the turn then tired at the top of the stretch. ITS THE RUSH settled off the pace, was hustled on the turn then tired in the stretch.
