MYSTERIOUS AFFAIR vied for the early lead inside of EL PRADO ESSENCE, entered the stretch a head behind, but responded well and edged clear in the final sixteenth under right handed urging. RUBY PARK was allowed to settle in the three path, angled to the four or five path midway through the turn and found her best stride in the late going getting up for place. EL PRADO ESSENCE was well rated vying for the early lead outside of the winner, entered the stretch under a tight hold and in front by a slight margin, but weakened in the late going and gave way for place. AHEAD BY A CENTURY was taken back and unhurried early, roused along the rail on the turn and finished with a late gain inside of rivals. JULIE'S WITT stalked the early pace outside of rivals, then dropped back on the turn. DOG GONE HOUND stalked the early pace outside of rivals, but dropped back on the turn and was eased in the stretch.
