BEAR NO JOKE stalked the pace, closed five-wide late turn, launched an all out drive, bid midstretch and got by late. ICE DANGER forced the pace, bid three-wide late turn, dueled, led briefly in the stretch but failed to stave off the winner in the final 16th. QUICK CODE, in range nearing the turn, chased along the rail and finished all out. EDDINGTON LIMIT set a pressured pace, was engaged late turn, dueled, then yielded a furlong out and tired. JADRAN raced midpack, angled three to six-wide on the turn, was hustled into the stretch and finished gamely. MAGOO, in touch, angled two to four-wide on the turn, chased into the stretch but had no late response. CAPTAIN CHRIS raced off the pace along the rail and never reached contention. BEACON HALL, rated off the pace, angled two to six-wide through the turn but failed to menace.
