RESCUE SEARCH led early, set the pace then held sway under a hand ride. PHIL'S DREAM stalked the pace, chased three-wide late turn but failed to gain in the late stages. SHY LOVER, away alertly, was quickly headed, stalked the pace, chased hard three-wide late turn and was all out through the stretch. ROB THE CRADLE raced off the pace, was hustled four to seven-wide through the turn then rallied gamely but late. CHIEF EXECUTIVE raced midpack, was hustled late turn and finished under an all out drive. SMART EXECUTIVE, in range, came six-wide through the turn, chased into the stretch but evened out late. NORTHERN STORE, well back early, was hustled along the rail and two-wide on the turn then tendered a mild late run but did not threaten. HEAVENLY EXECUTIVE, well back early, was hustled angling from the rail to five-wide on the turn then finished gamely to no avail. SPANISH PLAYBOY, in range early, came five-wide through the turn then flattened out in the stretch. TRAJECTAMAX raced midpack, came four to six-wide through the turn, was roused at the top of the stretch but was never a threat. CARDIAC REHAB, close early between foes, was hustled three-wide late turn and tired in the stretch. RODEO BOY, in range early, chased four and five-wide from midpack on the turn then lacked a rally. MOLINARO FT SASSY, in touch early, was hustled along the rail then two-wide on the turn but tired in the stretch.
