MOVIE ROCK stalked early then forced the pace on the turn, launched an all out bid upper stretch, took command just into the final furlong and finished under a drive. ICEMAN JACK stalked from the outside, was hustled five-wide late turn and finished willingly. BLUSHING SIR BRAHM, in range, chased five-wide into the stretch, was all out but evened out late. BIG BOPPER set a pressured pace from between foes, was hustled hard into the stretch but was headed in the final furlong and tired. AWESCARS WILDAGAIN forced the pace, chased six-wide giving way late turn then finished gamely in vain. RINZAI

raced midpack, saved ground, chased into the stretch but did not menace. GOLD ACCOUNT, in range, angled five to seven-wide on the turn, chased in the stretch but evened out late. TRAJECTORY'S DREAM raced off the pace, raced three and four-wide on the turn then flattened out in the stretch. CARTERS HOPE stalked three-wide, was roused at the top of the stretch but had no response. RUN FOR TAMMY was used early to gain contention, stalked the pace along the rail then tired a furlong out. FOUND THE TREASURE raced off the pace, came four and five-wide through the turn and lacked a rally. ONCEAROUNDTHEBAY, well back early, was steadied midway of the backstretch behind rivals, was hustled on the turn but did not threaten. PLAYBOY AT HOME raced midpack, was set down upper stretch, lost his path midstretch and flattened out.
