MOSELEY'S GIFT, well back early, came three to five-wide through the turn, took command a furlong out and widened under light pressure. SPANISH POST set the pace in hand, drifted a bit late turn and in the stretch, was passed a furlong out but was best of the rest. PEPLOE, well back early, came three and four-wide through the turn then rallied belatedly. LA DURA stalked the pace, chased into the stretch but evened out in the final 16th. LADY BOUDREAU raced midpack, angled from two to five-wide through the turn, chased to the end but did not menace. SUE THE TIGER, well back early, saved ground then rallied belatedly. AWISHYORHEARTMAKES was always outrun. NO MORE CATS stalked the pace, was hustled late turn then tired in the stretch.
