SHOAL WATER stalked the pacesetter in hand while three-wide, was asked for run upper stretch and responded smartly, drove clear inside the furlong marker and held sway under a drive. PRINCE ALPHIE well back early, gained four-wide late turn and finished determinedly. LE CINQUIEME ESSAI always in range and under strong rating between horses, lacked a path upper stretch then finished gamely when clear. MR. SULU was well back early, came four-deep out of the turn, lacked room behind a wall of horses at the head of the stretch, angled out and finished gamely but late. TUSAYAN was well back early, circled five-wide out of the turn and failed to threaten. RELAUNCH STAR showed speed and set a reserved pace then yielded quickly when challenged in the stretch. HARD EDGE trailed on the inside, lacked a path behind horses in the stretch and did not menace. FORD EVERY STREAM raced midpack along the rail then lacked a rally. ANGLIAN PRINCE stalked three-wide to the stretch then flattened out. TACKLING STRESS stalked the pace from the inside but tired in the stretch.
