Footnotes

NASHINDA led quickly, set the pace in hand, drew clear midway of the backstretch, widened leaving the turn and continued to draw off under a hand ride. ONE FOR ROSE, off a step slowly, stalked the pace, angled off the rail midturn and launched an all out rally and just got up for the place. SILVER BIRD stalked the pace to the stretch then was all out but could not stay close. GRAB BAG stalked the pace, raced three-wide through the turn, came four-wide into the stretch but lacked the necessary closing response. ROMAN ROMANCE broke alertly but settled quickly, raced off the pace on the third path, moved to the rail for the stretch drive but lacked a response when roused. EXPECT AN ANGEL settled early, raced four-wide on the turn, closed six-wide into the stretch then flattened out in the final furlong. LIT DE JIMMY, always well back, saved ground then lacked a rally.
