BEAR'S CONDUCTOR raced midpack, was shuffled back early turn, was set down at the top of the stretch, rallied gamely and was just up in time. BECKY'S KITTEN, in touch, stalked on the turn, closed upper stretch, collared the leader and challenged a furlong out, vied briefly, gained the lead also briefly, then failed to contain the winner at the wire. MY BAD set a reserved pace, quickened upper stretch, was caught a furlong out, dueled briefly and gave way grudgingly. RIVER HEIGHTS raced off the pace, angled from two to five-wide on the turn, was set down upper stretch and rallied belatedly. WORTH A PUNT was also off the pace, angled from the rail to three-wide on the turn, chased into the stretch and finished determinedly. PIT ALLEY, well back early, angled out closing late turn, rallied six-wide but failed to menace. COFFEE BAR stalked the pace, closed along the rail late turn, failed with a bid at the top of the stretch and flattened out. MAPLE TINTS raced off the pace, angled from two to five-wide through the turn then lacked a strong closing response. CASUAL DUDE stalked the pace three-wide, chased four-wide into the stretch and tired.
