Footnotes

BEARS REDNECK raced off the pace, saved ground, was hustled into the stretch, rallied inside rivals and got up late, driving. OCCASIO, in range early, raced midpack angling three to five-wide on the turn, launched an all out stretch drive, gained steadily and missed. MOLINARO FORT raced midpack, closed between foes into the stretch, was all out to the end but missed. BLUSHING BRAT stalked the pace, chased three and four-wide from midturn, gained the lead in the final furlong, moved clear but failed to hold in the late stages. GOLDY SONG raced midpack, was hustled three to six-wide on the turn, rallied, but evened out late. ARGENT STAR led early, set the pace, was collared in the final furlong and tired. CALM NIGHT raced three-wide from off the pace, closed into the stretch but never reached contention. AIR STRIKE stumbled at the start but recovered quickly, was hustled along in striking range, chased four and five-wide on the turn then tired in the stretch. CRAFTY MCNABB raced off the pace, closed up outside rivals on the backstretch, came four

to seven-wide through the turn then flattened out. MISTER DO IT, close early, was hustled three-wide on the turn then tired in midstretch. GOLD XCHANGE, in range early, was hustled midpack from the rail on the turn then tired in the final furlong. JUST GO EASY, close early, chased four-wide to seven-wide on the turn then tired at the top of the stretch.
