### Footnotes

SEAWATCH raced off the pace, was hustled four to seven-wide on the far turn, rallied and wept by the leader in the final furlong and finished under a hand ride. MARK'S SOUL raced off the pace, angled three to six-wide on the far turn, rallied gamely and was just up for the place. SPEED RING raced midpack, closed five-wide on the far turn, launched a bid upper stretch but was outkicked. ACTION PLAN stalked the pace, bid into the far turn, gained the lead, was headed midturn, chased to the stretch and evened out. BEAR'S TIZZ, in range, chased hard late turn but evened out midstretch. STUNNING SPLIT, in range, bid midturn and gained a short lead, was headed in the final furlong and tired. DIEGO BAY, well back early, was hustled on the far turn and rallied belatedly. DELAWANA raced off the pace, was hustled four-wide on the far turn then tired midstretch. PUT IT ON HOLD stalked the pace, failed with a bid into the far turn, chased, then tired late turn. SERIOUS INDEED, in range, closed into the far turn, chased to the top of the stretch and tired. READYMAN raced off the pace, was hustled two and three-wide on the far turn but never reached contention. BEAR'S GODFATHER led early, drew off on the backstretch then tired at the far turn.
