LET'S GO BEAR broke inward, moved up to duel on the backstretch, gained a short lead early turn then held through the stretch under a drive. READY RESPONSE dueled on the backstretch, forced the pace through the turn then was all out in the stretch and was gaining at the end. BOXING RING was hustled from midpack on the turn, chased three-wide into the stretch but did not threaten. CHARLIE MOON dueled then forced the pace, backed away a bit early turn, chased, then evened out in the stretch. EBERLE, up close on the backstretch, chased hard five-wide on the turn then flattened out in the stretch. BEAR KANDO, off a step slowly, raced well back, was hustled two and three-wide on the turn but was not a threat. LLEWELLYN raced midpack, was hustled four and five-wide on the turn then lacked a closing response. MOLINARO HONOR, off slowly, was hustled from the early stages, came four to eight-wide through the turn then lacked a stretch response. SURPRISE STAR raced midpack, was hustled hard three to seven-wide on the turn then tired in the stretch.
