SOCIAL CHARTER sprinted to an early lead and was unchallenged there after, then widened the advantage in the stretch under intermittent urging. VICTOR COOLEY was unhurried early in the three path, rallied 3 wide through the 2nd turn, but was no match for the winner. JAZZ CLUB stalked the early pace just off the rail, stayed off the rail around the 2nd turn, then weakened in the stretch. A FLEETS DANCER saved ground to the far turn, roused in the 2nd turn, angled outside of the leaders in mid stretch and finished well. NORTHERN SKY was rushed leaving the gate, then checked heading into the first turn, moved off the rail and was void of early speed, went between horses around the 2nd turn and finished with a mild rally. STEPHANOTIS was allowed to settle while saving ground, failed to respond when asked in the 2nd turn and finished evenly. ZACHAROV trailed early while off the rail, made a mild bid 4 wide in the stretch, but was never a threat. SUNSHINE JOURNEY was void of early speed in the five path and outrun. MT. SASSAFRAS was void of early speed and never a factor. CACHE IN stalked the early pace from the four path, dropped back heading into the far turn, then eased in the stretch.
