Footnotes

WHISKY SWISH, unhurried early, moved from the rail to the fourth path while closing on the turn, took command upper stretch and prevailed, driving. MORNING PRAYERS stalked three-wide, chased on the turn then finished determinedly. PRETTY PRISSY stalked the pace, was boxed in along the rail late turn then was all out through the stretch. HUCKLEBERRY'S GAL, in touch between horses, closed late turn but evened out in the stretch. MARDEN HILL settled, was hustled three-wide on the turn then tendered a mild late run. SAN DIEGO NIGHTS set a pressured pace, shook clear leaving the turn then tired upper stretch. HYDETHETREASURE forced the issue, chased late turn and tired. LOULA, in touch early, raced four-wide through the turn then lacked a late response.
