HEART OF A KING stalked the leader into and through the turn then bid outside into the stretch, too command and was clear at the wire. D'ORO DIABOLO led the way into and through the turn from off the rail then could not match the winner in the final furlong while clear of the rest. CALIMONCO never far back, bid inside in the run to the wire and held the show over outside foe. ENUMERATE in mid pack, had a belated outside rally but it was not enough. BOLD NURSE in touch early, was still a factor into the stretch then tired. GENERAL BROCK had an outside trip and finished outside to no avail. COUNTER MOVE outside foes early from mid pack, failed to rally. STRAY CAT STRIDE between foes at the back of the pack in the early going, was never a factor. DUBLIN LANE inside and off the pace in the early going, had a dull effort.
