ST. NICHOLAS ABBEY was close up seven-wide into the clubhouse turn, took command, set the pace, was hard ridden on the far turn then held sway under a drive. CUTIE GIRL closed from off the pace on the backstretch, chased on the turn then evened out in the stretch. BUCK HUNTER raced off the pace, was hustled angling from two to four-wide through the far turn but never reached contention. KALYPSO KERRY raced off the pace, was hustled four and five-wide on the far turn but was not a threat. WONN BRITE BAYB stalked early, chased on the far turn then tired in the stretch. TOMMY'S GAL, rated off the pace, was hustled three-wide on the far turn then lacked a closing response. LET'S GET TO IT showed brief speed, was headed midway of the first turn, gave way gradually and was through by the far turn.
