LEADING ROLE stumbled at the start, but recovered quickly and rushed to contention inside of the early leader SCREEN HAPPY, put that one away in the drive and drew clear under steady pressure. WAGER'S JOY stalked the early pace inside of rivals, angled out entering the stretch and got up for place. NO CHEATING stalked the early pace three wide and ran evenly. SCREEN HAPPY broke sharply and pressed the early pace, then weakened in the stretch. OUT WELL was void of early speed, swung wide on the turn and finished with a mild rally. WYNYARD was unhurried early in the three path and never a threat. SINHOUSE showed little and was outrun. WHAT A BREEZE was void of early speed and never a factor.
