**Footnotes**

MON AMI AMY took command on the first turn, set the pace in hand, was pressured on the far turn, dueled into the stretch then drew clear and held TEMIS (CHI) safe under a drive. TEMIS (CHI) was unhurried early, moved off the rail early on the far turn and closed three-wide, came five-wide into the stretch and rallied determinedly. POKA DOT PRINCESS had speed from the gate, relinquished the lead on the first turn, pressed the pace to the far turn then tried in earnest to get to the leader, dueled briefly into the stretch but could maintain the pace and flattened out. ASMOKEAFTERDINNER closed along the rail into the final turn then finished evenly between horses. FAFNIR was unhurried to the final turn, closed along the third path but failed to threaten. WESTERLY FLOW stalked up close while widest of three, chased on the far turn and tired. REGAL WINGS raced midpack in striking range while three-wide, came four-wide into the stretch and tired. SWEET DREAMY SYN stalked from the rail to the far turn and tired. AMBER'S GLOW was always far back, raced three-wide and did not menace. SCUTTERBOTCH raced midpack while three-wide then tired badly on the far turn.
