D'WILD BEACH pulled to the fore on the backstretch, dueled briefly and took a short lead into the turn, set a pressured pace, shook clear into the stretch then held under a drive. GOLD DUST LADY stalked three-wide, launched a determined drive from the top of the stretch but hung late. BIBI'S DOLL, off slowly, stalked along the rail, was all out in the stretch but hung late. HEAVENLY PRIDE, in range at the rear of the pack, chased three and four-wide on the turn then rallied late outside rivals. LUCKY MELISSA stalked from between foes, chased into the stretch but had no late response. MEDABUCK led early, was pressured then headed at the turn, forced the issue, gave way late turn and evened out in the stretch. TRIPPI'S SAILOR broke in the air, raced in touch with the leaders, was hustled along the rail late turn but tired in the stretch.
