YOSHI MORI showed brief speed, was headed and stalked the pace, bid into the turn, dueled, shook clear into the stretch, came out when given left-handed encouragement then straightened away and held under a drive. TOTAL BLISS, in touch, chased hard on the turn, launched a determined stretch drive and was gaining late. SO LOVELY, in touch between foes, chased into the stretch and rallied mildly. ZEE'S CURE raced in midpack, was hustled on the turn but never reached contention. STILL OWING stumbled at the start, was hustled from midpack on the turn, came five-wide into the stretch and did not threaten. WHITE ROAD raced in midpack, was hustled along the rail on the turn then evened out in the final furlong. SIESI forced the pace into the turn, kept after the leader, chased into the stretch, was closed off and checked sharply then evened out. CLASSICAL VIVIANA settled off the pace, closed late turn then rallied late between rivals. PERRITO raced off the pace, was roused late turn but gave no serious response. OLD COOKSVILLE showed early speed, was headed and forced the pace on the turn but tired upper stretch. NITA MARU raced in midpack, chased into the stretch then evened out. TOURIST RESORT raced in midpack, was hustled between rivals late turn then flattened out in the stretch. BELLA PARIS NOEL raced in midpack, was hustled along the rail on the turn then tired in the stretch. UPTOWN RAY, steadied just out, trailed throughout. A STEWARDS' INQUIRY INTO THE STRETCH RUN CONCERNING YOSHI MORI AND SIESI RESULTED IN YOSHI MORI BEING DISQUALIFIED AND PLACED SEVENTH FOR INTERFERENCE WITH HER RIVAL AT THE HEAD OF THE STRETCH.
