Footnotes

AMAZONIAN RACEKEY was allowed to settle inside of rivals, roused in the backstretch and drew even approaching the far turn, dueled to the stretch, opened a clear lead entering the stretch and was all out holding off a late closing SAN BON WAY. The latter was unhurried early outside of rivals, roused well off the rail on the second turn and rallied belatedly in the drive. BLUE SKY LADY was void of early speed along the rail, started a rally on the turn, but was blocked and checked, slipped through entering the stretch and closed willingly in the final furlong. CARAWAYS FLYING T vied for the early lead between horses, dueled outside of the winner on the turn, but weakened in the drive. A LOT LOUDER was void of early speed, swung wide on the turn and

finished with a mild rally. DEVILNESS was allowed to settle inside of rivals, closed the gap on the turn, but flattened out in the drive. RACY RAQUEL was void of early speed between horses, closed the gap on the turn, but flattened out in the drive. SPIRIT OF PATXI was void of early speed between horses, roused five wide on the turn and finished with a mild bid, but was never a threat. CLASSY PICKUP was close up four wide in the early going, then dropped back on the second turn. DARLIN' DOMINIQUE was void of early speed, roused between horses on the turn and passed tiring rivals in the drive. NITE TIME QUEEN was rushed to contention and vied for the early lead three wide, then tired on the turn and dropped back. SCARLET D'OR raced five wide on the first turn and was void of early speed, never rallied and was never a threat. PORT MARIA stalked the early pace inside of rivals, but faltered in upper stretch and faded.
