MR. ROD, rated midpack, closed late turn, took command four-wide upper stretch and drove clear a furlong out. RUNAWAY MY WAY stalked the pace from between horses, chased three-wide into the stretch then rallied between foes. ROCKETMAN ROB raced off the pace, closed three and four-wide on the turn, chased in the stretch then evened out late. RANGER DAN, away alertly, was quickly headed and pressed the pace, bid into the turn, dueled and gained a slight advantage, dueled into the stretch and yielded a furlong out. TIME FOR A WINNER set a pressured pace, dueled on the turn, was hustled hard late turn then tired upper stretch. CASHININ ONA DREAM, taken back early, rated off the pace, chased four-wide late turn but was not a threat. D'WILD MAN broke in the air, was hustled early from midpack, saved ground through the turn then tired upper stretch.
