NEXT QUESTION set a pressured pace, moved clear while three-wide on the turn then held JOLSON safe under a drive through the stretch. JOLSON forced the issue, chased on the turn, was all out in the stretch and was gaining late. C. C. RIDE, off slowly, raced close up between foes, chased three-wide on the turn and finished all out. GUITAR SOLO raced in midpack, chased five-wide on the turn and was all out through the stretch. BIJOUX BON, off slowly, raced off the pace, closed three-wide through the turn then evened out late. BRAIN POWER broke outward ,settled off the pace late backstretch, was hustled along four-wide to six-wide on the turn but was never a threat. PREMIER JE SUIS settled off the pace, was hustled along the rail on the turn then evened out in the stretch. BEAR MONEYMAKER forced the pace to the turn, began to give way, then faded.
