SNEAKY MONEY, away slowly, settled off the pace, closed on the backstretch, bid midturn, shook clear at the top of the stretch and held sway under a strong hand ride. EL RIO BRAVO raced off the pace, closed on the far turn, chased four-wide into the stretch and finished determinedly. CRAFTY MCNABB, well back early, was hustled through the far turn, circled five-wide into the stretch and rallied outside. GOLD BOOK, rated off the pace, chased four-wide on the far turn and was all out through the stretch. CASH FOR LIFE settled off the pace, was hustled on the far turn then evened out in the stretch. SILO RIDGE, off slowly, stalked the pace, bid early turn, dueled, then tired at the top of the stretch. RIVAS RUN raced in midpack, was hustled on the far turn then evened out in the stretch. SLEW THE MAESTRO forced the pace early, stalked on the backstretch, bid early turn, dueled, but tired nearing the stretch. SEA BANK had speed, widened early backstretch, was caught at the turn, dueled briefly and tired.
