

DARK ENDING escaped unaffected when TREASUREINMYHAND broke down on the first turn, was well rated along the rail in the backstretch stalking the pace, drew even outside of TURNER'S HALL entering the stretch and went on by under strong left handed urging. The latter assumed command on the first turn when the favorite broke down, opened a clear margin in the backstretch, but could not hold off the winner in the drive and was second best. ROYAL FACT was steadied mildly on the first turn, recovered quickly and stalked the pace from just off the rail, but failed to respond on the far turn and dropped back in the drive. GIVING NOREEN was bumped badly and forced wide midway through the first turn, ended up well off the lead along the rail in the backstretch, made a mild rally in the drive, but was never a threat. PENNY PERFECT was four wide on the first turn when forced wide and steadied, moved back to the three path in the backstretch and was never a threat. TRANSCENDENTAL was forced very wide in the first turn and dropped back to last, never rallied after that and was never a factor. TREASUREINMYHAND set the pace to the first turn, but broke down and bored out into rivals while being pulled up.
