### Footnotes

GUIPAGO raced well back early, was roused along the rail late turn, finished all out and got up late. MONTROSE AVENUE stalked the pacesetter then vied briefly early backstretch, moved clear and set the pace then held to deep stretch and missed. KING EDDIE, unhurried early, angled from three to six-wide on the far turn then rallied outside. ASCOT'S LEGEND stalked the pace, forced the issue from the rail inside the leader into the turn, could not stay inside and chased to the stretch, was all out to the end but hung. DOCTOR JACK led early then vied briefly early backstretch, was headed but stayed close, chased on the far turn then flattened out midstretch. BAYLAND, close early, settled midpack, chased through the far turn then evened out in the stretch. FULL OF WISDOM was unhurried early, raced off the pace and never threatened.
