GENTLEMAN JACKSON stalked the pace, chased four-wide late turn, responded smartly upper stretch, swept by the leader a 16th out and widened under a drive. GRITTANI dueled from the rail, drove clear at the top of the stretch but failed to contain the winner with a 16th to run. FOREVER AWESOME dueled, was headed at the top of the stretch, chased to the late stages and evened out. MEGA RUSH raced off the pace, chased three and four-wide on the turn then rallied belatedly. IF AND ALMOST broke outward, was hustled along then evened out in the final 16th. CLEAR TURBULENCE, away awkwardly, raced well off the pace, came three and four-wide through the turn and never reached contention. BRUNNERA raced off the pace, saved ground but lacked a closing response.
