QUEEN'SPLATEKITTEN raced off the pace, closed five-wide on the far turn, bid near the top of the stretch, drove clear and was kept to business as he widened. WALKER'S LANDING, off a step slowly, closed on the backstretch, bid four-wide late turn but was outfinished. OH CANADA stalked the pace, dropped back a bit on the far turn, rallied five-wide and was determined to the end. SILVERLEO broke inward, forced the issue on the first turn, took a short lead early backstretch, set a pressured pace, quickened late turn, dueled into the stretch and yielded. CAFE ELEKTRIK (GB) raced midpack along the rail, angled out three-wide leaving the turn but lacked a strong closing response. BOW BELL REEF showed early speed, was headed early on the backstretch, forced the pace to midturn and gave way.
