CONSOLIDATOR JOE stalked the pace, chased hard late turn, gained steadily through the stretch and got up late, driving. ZIP IT NANCE dueled, shook clear on the main track, set a reserved pace then was all out in the stretch but failed to hold the winner safe. LUCKY LOTTO settled off the pace, closed late turn then rallied willingly, but late. TIERRA DEL TIGRE settled off the pace, trailed on the turn, angled out nearing the stretch then launched a belated rally. BEAR'S FUTURE, off slowly, raced in midpack, chased hard on the turn but evened out midstretch. KID CANUCK dueled briefly, dropped back nearing the turn, chased to the stretch and tired. BRIDGEBURNER dueled briefly then stalked the pace, chased on the turn and tired upper stretch.
