POPSICLE TOES, in touch, chased along the rail on the turn, drove to the lead at the top of the stretch and held MY ISLAND GIRL safe under a drive. MY ISLAND GIRL stalked the pace, chased four-wide late turn, lapped on challenging the leader in the stretch but hung. CLEARLY IN CHARGE, in range, chased five-wide late turn and was all out through the stretch. ABSOLUTE HEAVEN raced off the pace, was set down at the top of the stretch, rallied along the rail but evened out late. LUCKY N' BOLD was up close early, chased three-wide then angled five-wide late turn and finished determinedly. RIDE THE BULLET, in touch, dropped back, chased from early turn, came eight-wide to the top of the stretch but failed to menace. JOVIAL JILL raced midpack, was hustled four to seven-wide late turn then evened out midstretch. HIGHLAND HOLIDAY raced off the pace, steadied in tight quarters along the rail midway of the backstretch, was hustled along the rail on the turn then evened out in the stretch. KATZ REIGN broke alertly but outward, set a pressured pace, was headed at the top of the stretch and tired.
