HIGHLAND MOOD pressed the early pace outside of rivals, drew even at the quarter pole and edged clear in the final furlong under strong urging. FOXY DEVIL showed good early speed and set a pressured pace inside of the winner, grudgingly gave way in the final furlong and was a clear second. EBONY COUNTESS was allowed to settle four wide, roused on the turn and finished with a mild rally. CROWN'S SHADOW was hustled along inside of rivals, made a mild bid on the turn, but flattened out in the drive. RUBY TANGO was void of early speed, saved ground on the turn and rallied belatedly in the drive. GAMBOLWITHDESTINY was unhurried early between horses and lacked a late response. SHEZA A NINE PLUS was void of early speed off the rail, then passed tiring rivals in the stretch. DIRECT DEPOSIT broke in the air and was void of early speed off the rail, never rallied and was never a threat. CLASSIC GRATA was close up off the rail in the early going, then dropped back in the stretch. CRIMSON COURTIER was very washy in the post parade and hopped at the start, showed brief speed three wide, then faded badly on the turn.
