MISS TERRA showed speed and quickly took the lead, set the pace and was all out through the stretch. WICKED EMER dropped back early after a good beginning, closed four-wide on the turn and finished determinedly, getting up for the place. ABIRA raced off the pace between horses, closed four-wide late turn and finished determinedly. MIDNIGHT JOKER pressed the pace three-wide, was roused late turn but evened out in the stretch. SPANISH DEPUTY, close early between foes, dropped back on the turn then lacked a rally. SIT STILL raced off the pace, remained patient along the rail then was boxed in through the stretch. LA MANCHA forced the pace from the rail but tired upper stretch.
