Footnotes

CRYPTONITE KID, in touch while racing three-wide, closed into the stretch, bid and vied briefly then drove clear in the final furlong. SOUTHERN ARCH stalked two-wide, angled out at the top of the stretch and rallied gamely. FLASHY YANKEE stalked the pace in hand, was well in hand on the turn, bid upper stretch, dueled briefly then gave way grudgingly in the final furlong. RIVER HEIGHTS raced off the pace, angled three-wide to five-wide late turn then rallied belatedly and was gaining late. BACKGAMMON, well back early, came three-wide late turn, angled out and rallied belatedly outside. LITE THE CIGAR raced midpack, closed four-wide late turn then finished all out between foes. CAPTAIN MARK stalked along the rail and two-wide, was in striking range to

deep stretch and hung. STREET LEGEND stalked along the rail, was hustled through the stretch then evened out late. A P VALOR, well back early, raced two and three-wide on the turn then lacked a strong late response. CLARKSTONCHARM led early, set a reserved pace, was pressured on the turn, was engaged upper stretch and tired. PAYNES GOLD, well back inside, angled out upper stretch but never reached contention. EASTERMAN raced in the middle of the pack early along the second path, gained mildly in the stretch but flattened out late. SUN HAWK stalked from between horses, was in range to the final sixteenth then flattened out. POWER OF ATTORNEY, in range early, was hustled four-wide on the turn then tired in the stretch.
