GOOD GENERAL stalked the pace, moved up and dueled through the far turn and drove clear in the final furlong. LORD OF GREATNESS broke alertly, stalked the pace, bid into the turn, dueled between rivals then yielded in the final furlong. LADY'S FIRST CAT, off slowly, raced off the pace, swung out late turn, was roused, finished well and closed a gap. FREE TO FLY, in touch, chased on the far turn but tired at the top of the stretch. SEE U AT THE TOP set a reserved pace, dueled through the far turn, gave way late turn and tired at the top of the stretch. ALTONA ROAD raced off the pace, chased on the far turn but never reached contention. CHIEF BEAR raced midpack, was hustled on the turn then lacked a late response. COOL GATOR, in touch, chased on the far turn but tired at the top of the stretch.
