Footnotes

BIOFUEL raced off the pace, circled six-wide late turn, rallied smartly and swept by the leader midstretch and finished under a hand ride. ERNFOLD raced midpack, moved sharply up the rail to take the lead late backstretch, was clear midturn then failed to contain the winner a sixteenth out. MOMENT OF MAJESTY led on the clubhouse turn, set a slow pace in hand, was headed nearing the final turn, stalked to the stretch then finished all out. EMPIRE SPRING, rated off the pace, gained contention on the far turn, chased five-wide into the stretch and finished gamely. TEE GAME stalked the pace, closed late turn then flattened out in the stretch. REDVERSE, rated off the pace, was hustled late turn but never reached contention. WITCH'S COVEN, prominent early, was headed and forced the pace, dropped back at the far turn, chased briefly and tired at the top of the stretch.
