ARTIC FERN led early under strong restraint, quickened on the far turn, was engaged upper stretch but responded smartly when asked and drew away, finishing under a hand ride. MOBILIZER raced off the pace, closed six-wide late turn then rallied gamely. SO ELITE settled off the pace, closed and gained contention on the backstretch, moved up inside the leader entering the far turn, forced the pace, lodged a bid upper stretch but was no match and evened out. MONTESQUIEU stalked the pace, was roused on the far turn, was all out in the stretch but failed to threaten. ROMAN GAMES raced midpack in hand, was taken back a bit late backstretch, saved ground on the turn then flattened out in the stretch. BEAR STAR stalked the pace four-wide, was hustled five-wide late turn then tired in the stretch. PERFECT CREVASSE, rated early, chased late turn then tired in the stretch.
