SUPERBULL raced off the pace, closed angling three to seven-wide through the turn, rallied gamely, bid midstretch and prevailed under a drive. KLEINSRIDGE dueled from the outset, came out at the top of the stretch, was game then gave way grudgingly to the winner in the late stages. TWO AS ONE dueled from the rail throughout then gave way grudgingly to the winner in deep stretch. HOLY CRUSADER raced midpack, chased hard into the stretch and finished gamely. TRUE BELLAMY dueled, gave way a bit at the turn, chased, was steadied behind KLEINSRIDGE at the top of the stretch then finished determinedly. VEGAS, well back early, chased two to five-wide through the turn, cut to the rail upper stretch but faced with rivals out in front, angled off the rail a furlong out and finished gamely. PEASANT stalked the pace, chased late turn, was checked when he lost his path upper stretch and evened out. SUBLIME RHYTHM raced off the pace, came three to six-wide through the turn but was never a threat. REIGNERS LANE was always well back. PADMORE VILLAGE, off slowly, raced off the pace and lacked a stretch response. THE JOCKEY ON PEASANT CLAIMED FOUL ON TRUE BELLAMY FOR INTERFERENCE AT THE HEAD OF THE STRETCH, BUT A STEWARDS' INQUIRY INTO THE INCIDENT FOUND THAT KLEINSRIDGE HAD COME OUT AND BOTHERED TRUE BELLAMY CAUSING A CHAIN REACTION. KLEINSRIDGE WAS DISQUALIFIED AND PLACED SEVENTH. AFTER AN APPEAL, THE DISQUALIFICATION OF KLEINSRIDGE TO SEVENTH WAS OVERTURNED AND HE IS NOW PLACED SECOND.
