JAMES STREET, rated off the pace, closed five-wide on the far turn, angled inward to the third path then out again and chased five-wide from the top of the stretch, angled out a little more upper stretch, rallied gamely, got by late under light handling and was taken in hand nearing the wire. MESA CIELO forced the pace, dueled on the backstretch, bid late turn, gained a narrow lead, was pressured through the stretch, held off a challenger but failed to contain the winner in the late stages. CAPTAIN CARLOS raced off the pace, chased five and six-wide on the far turn, lapped on the leader in the stretch but couldn't get by. MOBTHEWARRIOR stalked the pace, chased four to six-wide on the far turn, finished all out but failed to menace. D'S WANDO set a pressured pace, dueled on the backstretch, gained a short lead on the turn, was engaged near the 1/4 pole then yielded upper stretch. COLD HARBOR forced the issue, dueled on the backstretch, chased on the turn, bid late turn but tired in the stretch.
