Footnotes

APRES MIDI raced off the pace, closed late turn, took command upper stretch and held sway under a hand ride. RIVER LEMON, well back early, angled out late turn and rallied six-wide. BEAR'S TENOR raced in midpack along the rail, angled out between foes late turn and finished gamely. GET A GRIP (IRE) settled off the pace, saved ground then rallied mildly. GREEN WEAVER raced off the pace, swung wide at the top of the stretch and rallied willingly. EMPIRE RISING raced in midpack between foes and finished evenly. BINKS FOREST stalked the pace, chased late turn, failed with a bid upper stretch and flattened out. CUVARA stalked the pace, chased late turn, moved to the rail at the top of the stretch then tired a furlong out. WELL READ settled off the pace, came five-wide through the turn then lacked a rally. ABSOLUTE POWER led early, was headed midbackstretch, stalked the pace, rebid midturn, took command, was collared upper stretch and tired. PROUD CANADIAN stalked the pace but tired late turn. POST RANCH moved up and took the lead midbackstretch, set the pace, was headed midturn, chased to the stretch and tired.
