BESO BONITA, in touch, bid late turn, HAD THE lead at the top of the stretch and held sway, driving. GUPPY SMUGGLER showed brief speed then forced the pace, bid between foes late turn, was headed at the top of the stretch and chased to the end. LEENANE'S LULLABY stalked the pace, chased on the turn, was all out through the stretch then evened out late. FOOLISH, off slowly, closed quickly to gain contention, stalked the pace, chased late turn then evened out in the stretch. DRAVA raced in midpack, chased six-wide late turn then failed to menace. TAKTIME, off slowly, led into the turn, was caught late turn, dueled briefly, was headed at the top of the stretch and chased to the end. DADDY'S GINGER raced in midpack, came two-wide through the turn but

never reached contention. PETITE DIVA had speed, gave way late backstretch and settled off the pace then lacked a rally. SING GRACIE SING settled off the pace, was hustled late turn but never reached contention. JUST THE ONE raced well back, was hustled on the turn but did not threaten. TWENTY BLACK stumbled at the start, recovered smartly and stalked the pace, was hustled on the turn but faded. PEYTES DEED TOLIFE, off slowly, chased from off the pace, was hustled on the turn but never reached contention. FLOWER GIRL, off slowly, raced off the pace and lacked a closing response.
