FAITH AND TRUST stalked the forced pace three wide, wore down rivals in the stretch to get by in time. BELLE DE NASKRA stumbled at the start, stalked the early pace three wide, pressed the pace four wide in the backstretch, was outside RED HOT GAL on the second turn, gave her best off the rail in the stretch. RED HOT GAL well placed, inside, advanced late in the backstretch to gain the lead on the second turn, gave way late. HEAD FOR HOME was four wide on the first turn, raced off the rail, finished well. HEIDI'S SECRET was four wide, gained mildly in the stretch. JANE B. A. raced inside, rallied mildly four wide. HEAVENS PASSPORT was four wide on the first turn, had the pace while under pressure three wide in the backstretch, gave way on the second turn. POW WOW LOUISE had a short lead early, pressed the pace from off the rail inside of HEAVENS PASSPORT in the backstretch, dropped back on the second turn. MEADOW GOLD trailed, passed a tired one. EMPRESS OF SHEBA was three wide, and faded.
