Footnotes

WALL STREET DAVE stalked from the rail, raced three-wide into the far turn, chased hard, then rallied outside and just got up in time. LOTAGUSKA bid early on the backstretch, vied then forced the issue into the turn, rebid late turn, was determined in the stretch, gained a slight lead midstretch but failed to contain the winner. KING TATE led early, set a pressured pace, dueled then gave way grudgingly in the late stages. FALCON LAKE pressed three-wide, bid midway of the far turn but weakened through the stretch. ONE MORE DAY raced midpack between horses, was hustled along the rail on the far turn then evened out. TETHRA'S RIPPER, rated early, was hustled three-wide late on the far turn, was under strong urging but showed no response. PABLO P., off a step slowly, was contentious on the backstretch, chased hard four-wide into the far turn then tired in the stretch. COOL IRONY raced off the pace, was hustled four-wide late turn, came six-wide to the top of the stretch and tired. CHICO PELIGROSO stumbled at the start and unseated his rider. A STEWARDS' INQUIRY INTO THE START LEFT THE RESULTS AS POSTED.
