MEDIDOCIHOSPISURG had early speed, was headed and stalked the pace, bid in earnest midturn, dueled into the stretch, was headed this time by GENERAL BROCK in the final furlong, dug in late and prevailed under a drive. GENERAL BROCK, always in range, closed into the stretch, challenged along the rail a furlong out, dueled and gained a slight lead, battled to the wire and just missed. HILLSWICK, in range, was blocked upper stretch, altered course, rallied determinedly but missed. EXTENDED VACATION, in range, was hustled four-wide late turn and rallied gamely. DA POSSE led quickly, was

headed nearing the turn, forced the issue, vied between rivals into the stretch and yielded. BRITISH BANKER raced off the pace, was hustled four-deep into the stretch, rallied but evened out late. LITTLE RED CHRIS showed early foot, settled and stalked the pace, chased six-wide into the stretch but failed to menace. NOT FOR ROYALS, in range, angled from the fourth path to seven-wide late turn then evened out in the stretch. PRIME TIME settled well off the pace, swung six-wide late turn but lacked the necessary rally. GOLDY SONG raced off the pace, was hustled along inside rivals then lacked a strong late response. JERICHO raced off the pace, was hustled late turn but never reached contention. MERCADO forced the pace, gave way on the turn, was in range to the top of the stretch then tired. PLURIES took a short lead into the turn, was pressured, vied into the stretch and tired. KENSINGTON OVAL raced off the pace, came four and five-wide through the turn, lacked a stretch response and tired.
