GOOD BETTER BEST set a pressured pace, moved clear into the stretch then widened under a hand ride. TH ORIGINAL SCOTTY stalked the pace, was hustled on the far turn and chased through the stretch. COUNTY LINEMAN settled in midpack, chased six-wide into the stretch but did not menace. PERSPECTIVE raced in midpack between foes, chased five-wide into the stretch but failed to menace. MIST OPPORTUNITY raced off the pace, chased late turn, came six-wide into the stretch but never reached contention. DRINK OR SINK stalked the pace, was hustled on the far turn and was all out in the stretch but evened out in the late stages. SMELLS LIKE GOLD raced in midpack, chased hard late turn then evened out in the stretch. MY KNIGHT INDEED, rated off the pace, chased eight-wide into the stretch but was never in contention. WONDER PHIL stalked the early pace, chased between foes late turn then flattened out in the stretch. FLIM FLAM settled off the pace, was hustled on the turn but never reached contention. CAPTAIN CROW, rated off the pace, was hustled on the turn, angled out nearing the stretch but lacked a rally. HONORABLE GUEST raced in midpack and came five-wide through the first turn, chased on the far turn then tired in the stretch. WAKEBOARDER had brief speed, forced the pace to late turn, chased into the stretch and tired.
