WHOAN COLORADO raced in midpack, chased four-wide into the stretch, rallied and went by a 16th out under a hand ride. AFTER DINNER dueled, held a short lead into the turn, was pressured but shook clear into the stretch then failed to stave off the winner in the final 16th. AFTERNOON IDOL raced in midpack, was hustled on the turn then finished gamely in vain. GIVEALITTLEMORE raced off the pace, came three and four-wide through the turn then rallied mildly. BENEVOLENT KNIGHT, bothered at the start, settled off the pace, was hustled on the turn and finished all out. EXTERNAL FIXATION stalked the pace, chased hard on the turn then flattened out in the final furlong. PIRATE PRINCE dueled, took back a bit to force the pace, chased hard trying to rebid on the turn but failed to get up and tired in the stretch. VILIK broke outward, settled off the pace, chased from the rail on the turn then had no response in the stretch.
