CONESTRELLAS, off slowly, settled off the pace, chased into the stretch then rallied willingly and got up late between rivals. CLEAR MARCH forced the pace, bid midturn, dueled, led briefly upper stretch, was joined midstretch, dueled, wore down that rival but was headed late by the winner. REIN IN AVARICITY stalked the pace, chased late turn, rallied then failed to sustain a late bid. TAPIA stalked the pace, bid midstretch, dueled, then gave way grudgingly in deep stretch. ALTA LAKE set a pressured pace, was joined midturn, dueled, then yielded upper stretch. HONEY BREW stalked the pace, chased into the stretch but evened out in the late stages. TREVI FOUNTAIN, rated off the early pace, saved ground and chased through the stretch. TAKER HOME raced off the pace, saved ground then tired in the stretch.
