**Footnotes**

SPEYSIDE stalked the pace, chased late turn, bid a furlong out, drove clear, then held under steady pressure. R PAYNES PRINCE raced in midpack, saved ground on the turn then finished all out along the rail. PORTLAND POINT, in touch three-wide, chased late turn and finished gamely. CRUSHIN HARD pulled on the backstretch and pressed the pace well in hand, chased from the top of the stretch then evened out in the final furlong. GOODNIGHT HAWK set a pressured pace, was joined midstretch, was headed then yielded position grudgingly in the late stages. CURLING ROCKS raced in midpack between foes, chased through the stretch but did not threaten. BEST BEWARE dwelt, closed on the backstretch, saved ground through the turn, angled out entering the stretch but came up empty. REMEMBER TO DREAM settled off the pace, saved ground and was never in contention. MY PARISIO raced in midpack, was hustled four-wide on the turn then lacked a rally. LOUISA'S GIFT broke outward, dropped back and trailed.
