MRS. MATHIAS forced the pace, took command nearing the turn, set the pace then held sway, driving. HIGHLAND HOLIDAY, rated in midpack, was hustled four-wide late turn, chased into the stretch and finished all out. WISE TRICK, off slowly, settled off the pace, chased along the rail on the far turn and finished all out. BIG APPLE RED raced off the pace, chased hard along the rail on the turn then evened out in deep stretch. BELLAMY BLUES stalked the pace, chased three-wide late turn then flattened out in midstretch. OCALA DAWN raced off the pace, was hustled four-wide late turn but never reached contention. JOVIAL JILL set a pressured pace, was headed late backstretch, chased briefly then backed away on the turn.
