MY MISS EMILY dueled four-wide then stalked the leader on the turn, rebid a furlong out and prevailed under a drive. TOWER OF HONOUR showed speed on the inside, shook clear on the turn, was engaged in the stretch, dueled to the finish and just missed. PEAKABOO PEAK stalked four-wide through the

turn then hung in the stretch. SKIP'N FOOL circled six wide on the turn then finished willingly, but too late to menace. TOUR D'STAR dueled three-deep then chased from the rail on the turn and tired in the stretch. CLASSY SOLUTION raced midpack and five-wide on the turn then lacked a late response. PETITE MERMAID was unhurried to the top of the stretch while two deep and failed to threaten. SLEWANNA was unhurried to the top of the stretch then passed tiring horses. CAT IN DEED dueled three-deep early, chased and gave way leaving the turn. G. T.'S GONE WEST lacked a rally after racing three-deep. JULES RULES raced midpack along the rail and flattened out in the stretch. SHARIDE had brief speed and faded on the turn. RAEWANDA was through early and tired.
