Footnotes

FLASHY ANNA was always in range between rivals, closed midturn, bid approaching the top of the stretch, drew clear then held NATURAL GLOW safe. NATURAL GLOW pressed the pace between rivals early, moved four-wide into the turn, continued to force the issue and bid in earnest at the 1/4 pole but was unable to wear down the winner. CAMP ON WOOD was well off the early pace, closed four-wide on the turn and finished willingly. VELVET SNOW showed speed early then settled just off the pace, raced three-wide in striking range and finished best of the rest. MATCHING SOX pressed the pace three-wide then flattened out in the stretch. CANADIAN CAT set a pressured pace to the 1/4 pole and gave way. EMBANK raced well off the pace along the second path and was never in contention. US TONIGHT was close early between rivals, remained contentious to the top of the stretch and tired. DEALING WITH DAISY well back in the pack between horses, was roused between foes early turn, moved to the rail but flattened out. WISTLA was unhurried early, saved ground then lacked a rally. HEART N SOLO showed little racing far off the pace along the rail. EXPLOITED NITES was through early and failed to respond when asked.
